#### J.B. LEFTWICH CHMA EDITORS' SCHOLARSHIP CUMBERLAND UNIVERSITY Lebanon, Tennessee

In 2011, an endowed scholarship was established at Cumberland University named the <u>J.B. Leftwich CHMA</u> <u>Editors' Scholarship</u> in honor of Lt. Col. J.B. Leftwich, longtime faculty member and faculty advisor of the *Cavalier* and the *Adjutant* staffs and a Cumberland alumnus. Three former editors (Huguenin,'59; Dowdy, '62, and Jewell, '62) created this tribute to "Coach" Leftwich and spearheaded administrative and fundraising arrangements. Other former editors and staff members, as well as family and friends, contributed to the endowment which provides an annual \$1,000 scholarship at CU.

Applicants should have a "dual major in Secondary Education and English." However, persons with a "demonstrated interest in writing, communications, or photography" may also be considered. The recipient will be a sophomore or above with a 3.0 or better GPA. Applicants need not be related to CHMA alumni or family members.
