Application Deadline Date: February 15, 2022 (postmarked)

Heights National Alumni Association will grant one scholarship in the amount of **\$10,000** for an incoming college freshman student for the **2022-2023 academic year**. This scholarship is in memory and in honor of CDR John L Sweatt, Jr (CHMA Class of 1959), and his father John L “COL” Sweatt, Sr (CHMA Biology Teacher).

This scholarship is available to anyone with some connection to Castle Heights Military Academy (including alumni, faculty, staff, descendants of alumni, faculty, and staff, spouses of alumni, faculty, staff, stepchildren of alumni, faculty, staff, etc.). **This scholarship will be for use at any accredited college or university in the United States for an ENTERING FRESHMAN.**

The selected recipient of the Sweatt scholarship will not be eligible to also receive one of the three \$2,000 scholarships offered by the Heights Alumni Association. To clarify the above sentence, applicants may apply for both the three \$2,000 scholarships and the one \$10,000 scholarship, however, if the applicant is selected for the Sweatt scholarship, they become ineligible for the other scholarships.

Only one member from the same family (i.e., brothers and/or sisters, etc.) will be eligible to be considered for this scholarship. If two applications are received from the same family, the family will be notified that only one of the applicants from the family may apply and the family will be asked to choose the family member they want the Sweatt Scholarship Selection Committee to consider.

In addition to establishing a relationship to Castle Heights Military Academy, applicants for this scholarship must have a cumulative high school **GPA of 3.5** and will need to provide an **official transcript (to be sent to the Sweatt Scholarship Selection Committee by the applicant’s registrar)**. **Transcript should include end of semester grades for Fall 2021.** Applicants should also demonstrate some involvement and/or leadership in extracurricular activities, honor societies, athletics, civic organizations, and community. **In addition, an essay will need to be written with a minimum of 500 words to a maximum of 750.**

Applicants should include a stamped, self-addressed envelope with the completed application. Once applicants’ files are complete, an acknowledgement will be sent confirming receipt of all application materials. **The Sweatt Scholarship Selection Committee will have a decision on the recipient of the \$10,000 scholarship by April 15, 2022. The scholarship winner will receive a letter of congratulations from the Chair of the Sweatt Scholarship Selection Committee, and his/her name will be announced in the June 2022 Heights National Alumni Association Newsletter.**

Applications will be evaluated by the Sweatt Scholarship Selection Committee, which consists of 3 members of the CHMA community. The Heights National Alumni Association will issue a check directly to the collegiate institution to be attended by the scholarship winner. Scholarship money may only be used for tuition, fees, books, and room/board.
